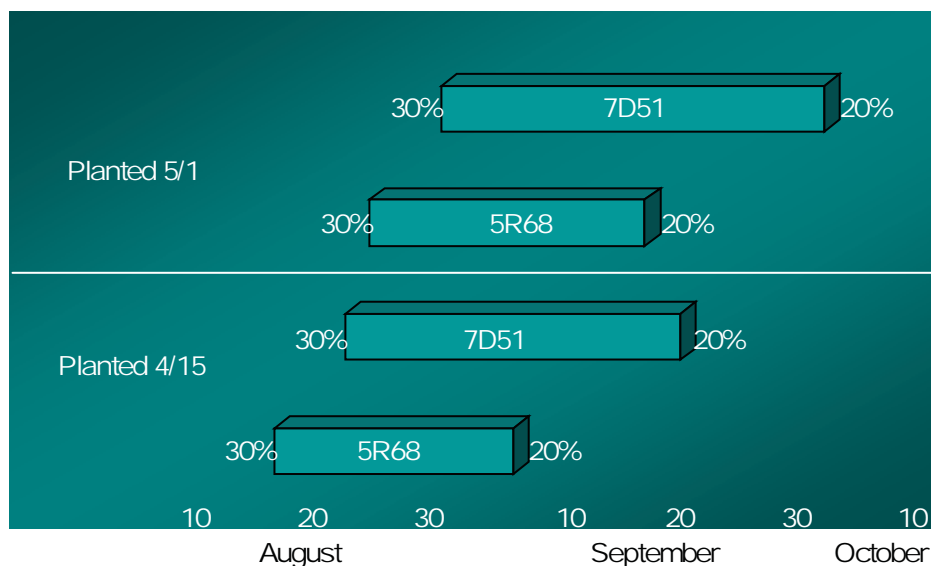

The Above Average growing degree day accumulations this growing season have allowed the corn crop to develop and mature at a record pace. If fields were not significantly delayed because of too much rain early in the growing season, harvest will be much earlier than average. The chart below shows for central Illinois and north-central Missouri projected grain moistures, assuming average temperatures for the rest of the growing season. Get the combines ready, harvest is coming soon!
